They are submitting a grant for funds to remove buckthorn and invasive trees and if they are removed along a river bank would like support from the SWCD for the project and cost share funds for tree replants to prevent erosion and sedimentation flow into the river. Goodrich had advised Mark to verify state cost share funds could be used with a state grant before we could commit funds. Discussion was held. A motion was made by Roiger and seconded by Stadick to authorize a letter of support for this grant application by the City of New Ulm.
